#### NOTIFICATION

G. O. (P) No. 102/2011/H. Edn. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 19th July, 2011.

**S. R. O. No. 444/2011.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Rules further to amend the Special Rules for the Kerala Collegiate Education Service, 1994 issued under G. O. (P) No. 41/94/H.Edn. dated the 21st March, 1994 and published as S. R. O. No. 350/94 in Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 241 dated the 21st March, 1994, namely :—

#### RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These Rules may be called the Kerala Collegiate Education Service (Amendment) Special Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of Rules.*—In the Special Rules for the Kerala Collegiate Education Service, 1994, in the Table under Rule 5, under the sub-heading “Class II Training Colleges”,—

(i) against serial No. 5 in column (1), for item 2 in column (3), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“2. M.Ed. degree with not less than 55% marks”.

(ii) The existing Note under category 5, shall be numbered as Note (1) and after Note (1) as so numbered, the following Note shall be inserted, namely:—

“Note (2)—The qualifications prescribed for appointment to various categories under the heading, “Class II Training Colleges”, shall stand revised in accordance with that fixed by the ‘UGC/State Government’ from time to time”.

### Explanatory Note

(The does not form part of the notification, but it is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per G. O. (P) No. 41/94/H.Edn. dated the 21st March, 1994 the Special Rules for the Kerala Collegiate Education Service, 1994 were issued on the basis of UGC scheme implemented for teachers in Universities and Colleges in the State. Later there was found some disparity in the qualification of Lecturers in Training Colleges in the said Rules with that of the University Regulations. Government have, therefore decided to amend the Special Rules suitably in order to facilitate appointments to be made to these posts.

These rules are intended to achieve the above purport.
