Applications are invited from qualified Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates of Kerala State for selection to the following post. Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after One Time Registration. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. The photo uploaded through One Time Registration should be the one taken after 31.12.2010 and also bear the name of candidate and the date of photo taken. The uploaded photo will be having a validity of ten years from the date of photograph taken.

1 Name of Department : Land Revenue

2 Name of post : Deputy Collector (Special Recruitment from SC/ST)

3 Scale of pay : 45,800-89,000

4 No. of Vacancy : 01(One)

Note:- The above Vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years, provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancy and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe during the pendency of the list. Candidates against vacancies exclusively reported for Scheduled Tribes will also be advised from this list and only in the absence of Scheduled Tribe candidates in this list that fresh notification for Scheduled Tribes for vacancies reserved exclusively for them will be issued.

5 Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes).

Note:- Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6 Age: : 20-41

(Only Candidates born between 02.01.1977 and

01.01.1998 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post). No

other age relaxation will be allowed.

Note:- In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7 Qualifications:

- 1. Must have obtained the B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com. Degree or any equivalent or higher degree of any recognized University.
- 2. Must satisfy a medical Board as to his Physical Fitness and capacity for active outdoor work.

Note:- 1) Deputy Collector Trainees appointed by Direct Recruitment will produce at the time of joining duty a Medical Certificate of health in the prescribed form from the Medical Officer of rank not lower than a Civil Surgeon Gr.I/ Professor, Medical College, before they are admitted to duty by the District Collectors, concerned.

- 2) Rule 10 (a) (ii) of Part II KS&SSR is applicable for this selection.
- 3) Those candidates who have claimed equivalency for qualifications should produce the Government

order proving the same at the time of certificate verification in order to consider as equivalent.

4) If the caste of candidates is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC book, they should claim their original caste in their applications and should produce community certificate issued from concerned revenue authority and the Gazette Notification for the same at the time of certificate. verification.

8 1) Probation:

Every person appointed as Deputy Collector by Direct Recruitment shall from the date on which he completes the training be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

- 2) Tests: A probationer recruited as Deputy Collector, shall within the prescribed period of probation, pass the following Tests, if he has not already passed the tests.
 - 1. The Revenue Test
 - 2. The Criminal Judicial Test (A candidate who possesses a degree in Law shall not be required to pass the criminal Judicial test).
 - 3. Account Test (Lower)
 - 4. Survey Test (Higher)

Training:- Every person recruited shall also undergo such a training as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time. Such persons shall during the period of training draw allowances, as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time. The period of training shall not count for increments in the time scale of pay.

9 Mode of Submitting application:

Candidates must register as per 'One Time Registration' with the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link while applying for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a printout of the details in the profile by clicking the link Registeration Card. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of each application, the candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is treated as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after the last date of receipt of application. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. The profile correction made by the candidate or in the office of the Kerala Public Service Commission on request after the last date fixed for receipt of application will not be reflected in the application. Such corrections will be in effect on the date on which corrections have been made. Those who have Aadhaar Card should add Aadhaar Card as ID Proof in their profile.
