b) Diploma in Craftsmanship in the trade of "Draftsman(Civil)" or "Surveyor" obtained after 18 months course (followed by 6 months practical training) at the Industrial Training Institutes/Centres conducted by the Government of India, Ministry of Labour.

NOTE : 1) Candidates who have successfully completed the industrial Trainig of 18 months will also be treated as qualified even if they have not completed the period of practical training. But their appointments will be treated as provisional and will be regularised only after the completion of six months practical training. 2) Diploma in craftsmanship(Trade Test Certificate) in the Trade of Draftsman(Civil) awarded to private candidates without insisting on six months practical training will be treated as an alternative Qualification for

- direct recruitment to the post of II Grade Draftsman.
- c) Diploma in civil Engineering(2 year Course) of the Women's Polytechnic of the state.

Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at thetime of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

If the caste of the candidate is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC book, but they have claimed their original caste in the application, should produce community/NCLC certificate issued from the concerned revenue authority along with the Gazette Notification of the same, at the time of certificate verification.

Candidates can view and have a printout of the details in the profile by clicking the link Registeration Card. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of each application, the candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is treated as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing.
