- 7. Qualifications :-
 - (i) Must be able to read and write Malayalam or Tamil or Kannada.
 - (ii) Must be an Ex-servicemen (Territorial Army Personnel/GREF Personnel are not eligible to apply) .
 - (iii) For appointment to the post of Office Attendant, Chowkidar and Messenger, ability to ride bicycle is an essential qualification for male candidates. (Physically Handicapped candidates and female candidates are exempted from this for the post of Office Attendant.

Note:-

- (1) Physically handicapped candidates and female candidates are not eligible for appointment to the post of Watcher, Night Watcher, Watchman and Night Watchman.
- (2) Candidates possessing cycling qualification should note this fact in the relevant column of the application.
- (3) Only one common Ranked List will be prepared to the various post included in the Last Grade Service. Those who possess Cycling qualification will be selected and advised against vacancies in the post of Office Attendant, Chowkidar and Messenger, which required cycling qualification.
