1. Diploma in Bio Medical Engineering/Technology obtained after undergoing a regular course of study for not less than three years with 60% marks in the qualifying examination and a pass in Sections Aand B of AMIE will be considered as equivalent to a Degree in Engineering.

- 2. In the case of First or Second class Post Graduate Degree holders in Bio Medical Engineering/Technology, the prescribed 60% marks in the concerned branch for the basic degree will not be insisted upon.
- 3. The total marks of all the years/semesters of Engineering/Technology course in which University examinations are conducted shall be taken into account in calculating the 60% marks.
- 4. Percentage of marks obtained for the qualifying examination and details of experience should be furnished in the column prescribed for noting qualification in the application. Branch of Engineering /Technology should also be noted in bracket along with qualification.
