Note:- Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the Certificate, as given above. Vague statements such as "vision normal" etc. will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specifications are not as indicated above, the Officer issuing the Certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision, as the case may be. Otherwise, the Certificate will not be accepted.

Medical Certificates shall be obtained from Medical Officer concerned as detailed below:

1. For SI of Police (KCP) – Not below the rank of Civil Surgeon Grade I
2. For SI of Police (APB) – Not below the rank of Civil Surgeon.
3. For Excise Inspector – Not below the rank of Civil Surgeon Grade II
4. For Assistant Jailor Gr I – Not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon.

But a single Medical Certificate obtained from competent Authority can be used for all the posts provided:-

- (a) If SI of Police (KCP) is one among the posts, the Medical Certificate should be obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon Gr I.*
- (b) A Medical Certificate obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon Gr II is sufficient for all the posts except SI of Police (KCP).*
