1. Department : Health Services

2. Name of Post : Assistant Surgeon/Casualty Medical Officer

3. Scale of pay : Rs.45800 – 89000/-

4. Number of vacancy : Anticipated

The Ranked list published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the list.

Those who are appointed in the post should serve for four (4) years during the first ten (10) years of their service (including the period of training) anywhere in India or any other foreign country under defence service or services connected with defence, if required. Those who have completed forty five years of age are exempted from the above compulsory military service.

Note: As per GO(P)No.61/12/SWD dated 17.10.2012 differently abled candidates with Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy, Hearing Impairment are identified as suitable for appointment to this post. Hence differently abled candidates with Blindness/Low vision are not eligible to apply for this post.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment

6. Age limit : 18-42; Only candidates born between 02.01.1977 and

01.01.2001(both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual age relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities. (For conditions regarding age

relaxation see para 2 of the General Conditions.)

7. Qualifications : **1.**Degree in Modern Medicine (MBBS) or equivalent qualification.

2. Valid Registration with Travancore - Cochin Medical Council.

Note: 1. Candidates who claim equivalent qualifications instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualifications shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification.

2. In the case of difference in original caste/community claimed in the application and that entered in S.S.L.C book the candidates shall produce a Gazette Notification in this regard along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate/Community Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification.

3. Rule 10 a (ii) of part II of KS&SSR is applicable.

8 Method of submitting applications:

- Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission <u>www.keralapsc.gov.in</u> before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link 'Registration card' in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, age, community, etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
- (b) If a Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation on writing the examination through their One Time Registration . Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely.
