- Note:- (i) Separate Ranked Lists will be prepared for the above Districts in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked list thus prepared and published by the Commission, shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year, subject to the condition that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised for appointment against the aforesaid vacancies and also against the vacancies, if any, reported during the currency of the list. In case no candidate is advised from the ranked list till the expiry of the period of three years, the duration of the ranked list shall be extended for a further period of one year or till at least one candidate is advised from the list whichever is earlier.
 - (ii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O (MS) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS) No.4/61/PD, dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when

notified.

- (iii) Candidates should apply only to any one of the above mentioned Districts where the vacancy is existing and should note the name of the District concerned against the relevant column of the online application. Applications should not be submitted to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are submitted to more than one district in response to this notification, If applications are submitted contrary to the above direction, and if he/she is selected, his/her name will be removed form the Ranked List and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.
- (iv) In case of change in caste/community noted in the SSLC Book, candidates must claim their original caste/community in the application and shall produce caste/community certificate or Non-Creamy Layer Certificate as the case may be issued by the Revenue authorities and the original Gazette Notification publishing the change of caste/community at the time of OTR verification for selection to the above post.

- **6.** Age Limit : <u>18-36</u>. Only candidates born between 02.01.1984 and 02.01.2002 (both dates

02.01.1984 and 02.01.2002 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. Other backward Communities and SC/ST candidates are eligible for usual age relaxation).

<u>Note:</u> For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para (2) of the General Conditions under Part II of this Notification.

7. Qualifications:-

(1) General

A Pass in Pre-Degree or Higher Secondary Course (+2)

(2) Technical

A Pass in T.B. Health Visitors Course conducted by the T.B Association of India, New Delhi or any other equivalent qualification recognized by Government of Kerala.

Note :- (i) In the absence of persons with Technical Qualification those with HSS certificates (in science subjects) will be selected and they will be given 6 months training in the State T.B Centre, Thiruvananthapuram. The period of training will not count for probation or increment. But such candidates will have to execute a bond to serve the department for 10 years as Treatment Organiser for Tuberculosis Programme and the stipend for 6 months ie, ₹2480/-. The amount of bonded obligation is ₹2480/- together with a sum of ₹1240/- as liquidated damages.

(ii) <u>Probation:</u> Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he/she joins duty be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

Note:-(i) KS & SSR Part II Rule 10 (a) (ii) is applicable for selection to this post. (ii) Candidates claiming equivalent qualification should produce relevant Government orders during verification to prove that the qualification claimed is equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:-

Candidates must register as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" with the of Kerala Official Website Public Service Commission, viz. 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of taking the photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Candidates are responsible for the Registration Card in their profile. correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Candidates who have Aadhar Card should add Aadhar Card as ID proof in their profile.

- 10. If written/OMR/Oneline Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidate shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of admission tickets will be published in the Examination calender itself.
