3% vacancies will be reserved for persons with differently abled (locomotor disability /Cerebral palsy /Low Vision/ Hearing Impairment) as per GO(P) No.01/2013/SJD dtd 03/01/2013.

#### Note:-

- i) The above vacancy is now in existence and is obtained by apportioning vacancies reported from the Kerala State Co-operative Federation for Fisheries Development Limited (MATSYAFED) in the ratio of 5:3:2 with the first turn going to General Category. The vacancies for the same post if any, further reported within the period of this Rank List will also be divided in continuation of the division already made and vacancies for Society Category will be filled from the Ranked List published by the Commission in response to this notification. Candidates will be advised alternately from the Ranked List of general open market (Part I) Fishermen/Dependent of Fisherman (Part II) and Ranked list of employees of Fisheries Development Welfare Co-Operative societies (Part III), with first position going to General Open Market candidates.
- ii) As in the case of all advices of the Kerala Public Service Commission for recruitment against the vacancies of Government Departments, Public Sector undertakings etc. the rotation will be a continuous one. In absence of candidate under Part II (Dependent of Fishermen community) such vacancies shall be filled from Part III (Society Quota) If there is shortage of candidates in the Ranked List of employees of Fisheries Development Welfare Co- Operative societies, such vacancies will be filled from the Ranked List of general open market candidates. Such passed over vacancies will not be compensated later. The rules of reservation as laid down in the General Rules 14 to 17 of part II of KS&SSR 1958 will be

followed for appointment from the list.

- iii) The ranked list prepared and published by the Commission for the post shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list is published after the expiry of the minimum period of one year. Candidates will be advised for appointment against the aforesaid vacancies earmarked for the General Category during the period of currency of the list.
- iv) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a statewise basis.
- v) As per KCS rule 184 every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he/she joins duty be on probation for a total period of Two years within a continuous period of Three years.

- 6 Age

- : 18-50. Only candidates born between 02.01.1970 and 01.01.2002 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.
- 7 Qualifications:
- 1 Must have 3 (three) years regular service in any cadre in the Fishermen Development Welfare Cooperative Society and should be in service of the Fisheries Development Welfare Co-Operative society not only on the date of application but also on the date of appointment to the new post.
- 2 1) B.Com Degree from a recognized University2) 2 years experience as an Accountant in registered reputed firm.
- Note: i) Rule 10 (a) (ii) of Part II KS&SSR is applicable for this selection.
  - ii) Those candidates who have claimed equivalency for qualifications should produce the Government order proving the same at the time of certificate verification in order to consider as equivalent
  - iii) If the caste of candidates is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC book, they should claim their original caste in their applications and should produce community/NCLC certificate issued from concerned revenue authority and the Gazette Notification for the same at the time of certificate verification.
  - iv The requirement that the employees should be in service of the

society on the date of appointment will not be applicable to those who were recruited through the PSC to a post in the Apex/Central Societies reserved for the employees of the affiliated Primary Cooperative/Member Societies, provided they are continuing in service in that post.

v) The eligible employees of Fisheries Development Welfare Co-Operative Societies affiliated to Fishermen Development Welfare Co-operative Society who apply for the above post should obtain the Service Certificate from the **Registrar Of Fisheries** showing the details of service of the applicant, which render them eligible to apply for the post and should upload the same in their profile and the original shall be produced when required by the Commission. **Applications that upload Service Certificate at the time of submission will only be considered.** The Service Certificate should contain the following details.

Application which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
