Applications are invited from qualified **Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe** candidates of Kerala State for selection to the following post. Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after **ONE TIME REGISTRATION**. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. The photo uploaded through One Time Registration should be the one taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of the photograph taken should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of photograph taken.

- 1 Name of Department : Animal Husbandry
- 2 Name of post : Live Stock Inspector Gr II / Poultry Assistant/ Milk Recorder/ Store Keeper/ Enumerator (Special Recruitment for SC/ ST only)
- 3 Scale of pay : ₹20000-45800/-
- 4 No. of Vacancy : <u>District wise</u> Thiruvananthapuram - 1 (SC/ST only)
- **Note:(i)** The above Vacancy is now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled castes / Scheduled Tribes during the currency of the list. Candidates against vacancies reported exclusively for Scheduled Tribes will also be advised from this list and only in the absence of Scheduled Tribe candidates in this list fresh notification for vacancies reserved exclusively for Scheduled Tribes will be issued.
- **Note:(ii)** The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis subject to the Special conditions laid down in G.O (MS)No.154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List so prepared is not eligible for transfer to another District unless he/she complete five (5) years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former District. Even if, transfer is allowed after five (5) years, it will be subject to the orders contained in G.O(Ms)No.4/61/PD dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service, holding the post in any one District are restricted from applying for the same post in another District. But they can apply for higher posts when notified.
- **Note:(iii)** Candidates should note the name of the district against the relevant column of the online application.

- **Note:(iv)** Candidates from the Ranked List for District wise selection will be advised for appointment against the Headquarters vacancies also. As per the provision in G.O (Ms) 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971 appointments against the Headquarters vacancies will be started from Thiruvananthapuram District. Separate option need not be given for this.
- **Note:(v)** Candidates recruited by the Commission shall be appointed to the service provisionally and they shall undergo the Stockman training course/Livestock Inspector training course. After the successful completion of training, their provisional appointment will be regularized from the date of first appointment treating, their training period as regular service. Those who do not complete the course successfully in the first attempt shall be allowed 3 (Three) more chances to complete the course successfully even in the fourth attempt, their provisional appointments shall be terminated and they shall be discharges from service. There shall be no re-ranking of candidates based on the marks secured by them during the training.
- **Note:(vi)** Candidate selected will have to execute a bond in the prescribed form to serve the Government of Kerala for a minimum period of 5 years after the regular appointment. Those who leave the service in between or during training are liable to pay for the damage if any fixed by the Government.
- **Note(vii)** Each trainee will have to produce a certificate (in original) of physical fitness from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon. This certificate shall be produced as and when called for by the Commission.
- 5 Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from among Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribes only).
- **Note:-** Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.
- 6 Age : 18-41 Only Candidates born between 02.01.1979 and 01.01.2002 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

Note : In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7 <u>Qualifications:</u> A pass in VHSE in Livestock Management

Note : 1. Rule 10(a)(ii) of part II of KS&SSR is applicable

2. Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such

qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

- **3.** If the caste of candidates is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC book, they should claim their original caste in their applications and should produce community certificate issued from concerned revenue authority and the Gazette Notification for the same at the time of certificate verification.
- **4.** Differently abled persons are not eligible for appointment to the post.
- 5. Candidates who have made bogus claims about qualification and Experience in their application will be liable to disciplinary action, as per the Rule 22 of the KPSC Rules of procedure,1976, irrespective of whether they have attended the examination or not.

8 Mode of Submitting application:

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link for applying for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a printout of the details in the profile by clicking the link Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the Registration Card. personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of each application, the candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is treated as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. "Candidates who have AADHAAR Card should add AADHAAR Card as I.D proof in their profile".

- 11 If a Written / OMR / Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, Candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission tickets will be published in the Examination calender itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination.
- 12 Paragraphs two, three and twenty five (except the conditions laid down in Rule

3 (c), Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules) are not applicable to this selection.

13 Appointments are made on the basis of the rank position in the ranked list of candidates prepared in pursuance of this notification subject to the conditions laid down in G.O.(P) No. 21/76/PD dated, 17.01.1976 and G.O.(P) No.25/94/GAD dated, 22.01.1994 allowing special reservations to Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribes in accordance with the procedures made for this purpose from time to time and subject to the rules under sections 3(c), 17(a), 17(b) of Part II of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.
