(e) Selection

In addition to the qualification prescribed above every candidate will be subjected to a Physical Efficiency Test. The Physical Measurement of the candidates will be taken at the time of Physical Efficiency Test and those who do not possess the prescribed Physical Measurements will not be admitted for the Physical Efficiency Test.

Candidates must qualify in atleast five events out of the eight events for One Star Standard specified below in the Physical Efficiency Test .

Note: If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the Physical Efficiency Test, he will not be given further chance to participate in the test.

8. Conditions of Service

Persons recruited direct for appointment to the category of Armed Police Assistant Sub Inspector shall undergo training for a period of one year in the Police Training College and or in such other institutions as may be specified by Government or the State Police Chief. The period of training shall not be treated as duty and shall not be counted for any service benefits including increment, probation etc and during the period of training the trainee shall be paid such stipend as may be specified by Government from time to time. They will be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

9 Mode of Submitting application:

(a)Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have

registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and Password.
