**8. Probation :** Every person appointed to this post shall, from the date on which joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years of duty within a continuous period of three years.

# 9. Method of submitting applications:-

(a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission <a href="www.keralapsc.gov.in">www.keralapsc.gov.in</a> before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password.
