5. Method of appointment: Direct Recruitment.(from candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste Community only)

Note: ST Candidates will be considered in the absence of SC candidates. Applications submitted by candidates other than those belonging to SC/ST will be summarily rejected. No individual rejection memo will be issued.

6. **Age limit** : 18-41. Only candidates born between 02.01.1980 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post. (Including the relaxation as per para 2(i)

of the General conditions. For other conditions regarding the age relaxation, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions.)

- 7. Qualifications
- (1) Pass in Standard VII (New) or its equivalent qualifications.
- (2) Two years experience as Mazdoor/Helper in the operation of diamond core drilling in Central/State organizations/Public Sector undertakings.

Note:-

- **1.** Rule 10 a (ii) of part II of KS&SSR is applicable.
- **2.** Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.
- **3.** In the case of difference in original caste/ community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.
- 4. 8. Probation: Every person appointed to this post shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years of duty within a continuous period of three years.

9. Method of submitting applications:-

- (a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2011. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission.
