- 1. Women & Differently abled persons are not eligible to apply in response to this notification.
- **2.** Application received from candidates other than Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.
- 6. Age : 20 36, Only Candidates born between 02.01.1986 and 01.01.2002 (both dates included)are eligible to apply for this post. (No other age relaxation will be allowed)
- 7. Qualifications:
- (a) Must be a Graduate

Note: 1.If sufficient number of fully qualified candidates are not available, applications of those who have passed Pre-University/ Pre-Degree or equivalent examination of recognized University shall be considered.

2.Rule 10(a)(ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.

3. Those candidates who have claimed equivalency for qualifications should produce the relevant Government Order to prove the same at the time of verification in order to considered as equivalent. Candidates claiming higher /equivalent to the qualification for which equivalency is prescribed in the notification should produce equivalency certificate from concerned institution or Government order proving the equivalency.

4. If the caste of candidates is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC book, they should claim their original caste in their applications and should produce community certificate issued from the revenue authority concerned and the Gazette Notification for the same at the time of certificate verification.

Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specifications are not as indicated above, the Officer issuing the certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision as the case may be, otherwise the certificate will not be accepted. (d)Physical Efficiency

In addition to the qualification prescribed above, every candidate will be subjected to a physical efficiency test. (The physical measurement of the candidates will be taken before conducting physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurements will not be permitted to participate in the physical efficiency test.) Candidates must qualify at least five of the undermentioned eight events of one star standard which is the minimum requirement for the recruitment.

Conditions of Service:- Candidates selected for appointment shall undergo training for a period of one year in the Police Training College or in such other institutions as may be specified by Government or the Director General of Police. The period of training shall not be treated as duty and shall not be counted for any service benefits including increment, probation etc and during the period of training the trainee shall be paid such stipend as may be specified by Government from time to time. On appointment, they will be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years. Every person appointed to the post shall execute a bond before he joins for training to the effect that he shall serve the department for a minimum period of five years.

There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
