6 Age : 20 - 36.

Only Candidates born between 02.01.1986 and 01.01.2002 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. No other age relaxation will be

allowed.

7 Qualifications:

- (1) Diploma in Telecommunication/Radio Engineering or equivalent.
- (2) Experience in the repairs of Electronic Devices or Computers & Accessories for a period not less than 2 years from a Government recognised Institute.

Note: In respect of Defence Service Personnel 3 (Three) years experience in signal Corps (Supervisory) with total service of 5 years will be reckoned as equivalent qualification for Direct Recruitment.

- Those candidates who have claimed equivalency for qualifications should produce the relevant Government Order to prove the same at the time of verification in order to considered as equivalent. Candidates who create their profile from 01/01/2022 should upload photograph taken within the period of six months. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of taking photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing.
