- (v) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O (Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless she completes 5 years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS) No.4/61/PD dated 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

ii) Candidates who claim equivalent qualification shall produce the relevant Government order to prove the claim at the time of One Time Verification or as required by the Commission.

(2) <u>Physical:</u>

The minimum height shall be 152 cms.

(3) <u>Endurance Test:</u>

All candidates should successfully complete an endurance test of running 2.5 Kilometers race within 15 minutes.

(4) <u>Physical Efficiency Test:</u>

The physical measurement of candidates will be taken at the time of Physical Efficiency Test or Endurance Test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurement will not be admitted for the Physical Efficiency Test or Endurance Test. If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the Physical Efficiency Test or Endurance Test, and as a result she could not complete the events on the same day, she will not be given further chance to participate in the test.

(5) <u>Physique and Eye sight</u>:

(i) Must be certified by a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon/Junior consultant as to her physical fitness and capacity for active outdoor work. The Medical Certificate has to be produced as and when called for.
