- 5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
- 6. Age Limit : 22 36 Only candidates born between 02.01.1986 and 01.01.2000 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. Usual relaxation in the upper age limit shall be allowed to candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward classes (For other conditions regarding age relaxation, see para 2 of Part II General Conditions of the Gazette Notification).

7. Qualifications :

i A Degree in Law conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala

and

- ii Must be a member of the Bar and must have had not less than three years of active practice in Criminal Courts as on 1st January 2022
 - Note: (i) Certificate of Enrolment issued by the Bar Council & Experience certificate of Three years active practice in Criminal Courts as on 1st January 2022, issued by a Judicial Officer not below the rank of a First Class Judicial Magistrate, should be produced.

- (ii) KS&SSR Part - II Rule 10(a) (ii) is applicable.
- In addition to the qualifications prescribed in this (iii) notification, the qualifications recognized by executive orders or standing orders of Government as equivalent to the qualification specified for the post, in the Special Rules and such of those qualifications that pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the Government orders declaring equivalent / higher qualifications shall be produced as and when required by the Commission.
- (iv) The Degrees/Diplomas awarded by UGC approved Universities or Institutions established through an act passed by Parliament/State Legislative Assembly in accordance with the conditions laid down in G.O (M.S) No.526/PD dated 17.07.1965 are acceptable for appointment in Government Services.
- **Training:** (1)A person appointed as Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II shall, on and from the date of his/her appointment, undergo training for a period of 180 working days. Scheme of training will be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
 - (2)Such persons shall until he/she completes the training prescribed above, be entitled to such stipend as may be specified by the Government form time to time. On their joining duty after successful completion of training and examination, the period of training including examination, the period of extension of training if any, shall be treated as officiating service for the purpose of increment, pension and probation.
- 9. Agreement: A candidate appointed as Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II shall, before undergoing the course of training, execute an agreement in such form as may be prescribed by the Government in this behalf binding himself / herself.
 - (i) To undergo the entire course of the said training
 - To serve the Government after the completion of the training (ii) as Assistant Public Prosecutor for a period to be specified by the Government.

and

- (iii) To refund to the Government the stipend received by him/her during the period of his/her training, if he/she resigns his/her appointment before the completion of the said period on any account except on the ground of ill-health which shall be certified by a Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon.
- 10. Test: A candidate appointed as Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II shall, within the period of probation, pass the Account Test for Executive Officers of the Kerala State or the Account Test (Lower) of the Kerala State, if he has not already passed any of those tests.

11 Mode of submitting Applications:-

- (a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2012. Candidates who have created new Profile from 01.01.2022 should upload their Photograph taken within a period of 6 months. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the print out of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondence with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application.
