(3) The Selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on district wise basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) no. 154/71/PD dated 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one district from the Ranked list prepared for that District is not eligible for transfer to another District for a period of 5 years form the date of commencement of regular service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after 5 years, it will be subject to the rules in G O(p) no. 36/91/P&ARD dated 02.12.1991 for inter district transfers in same Department and GO(p) no.5/2013/P&ARD dated 06.02.2013 for inter departmental transfers. But as per GO(p) 12/96/P&ARD dated 16.03.1996, the condition of 5 years service is not applicable for the transfer to the Districts of Idukki, Wayanad and Kasaragod. This concession will be available only for getting transfer into these districts, but not for getting transfer out of these districts and this concession will be granted only once in the career of a Government Servant. Candidates already in Government Service holding the post in any one district are prohibited from applying for the same post in another district. But they can apply to higher post when notified.

5. Method of appointment: Direct Recruitment(From qualified candidates belonging to the qualified Hindu Nadar Community only)

 6. Age limit: 18-39:- Only candidates born between 2.1.1983 and 1.1.2004 (Both dates included)are eligible to apply for the post. (Including the age relaxation in para 2(1) of Part II of General conditions.) (For Concessions allowed in upper age limit subject to the conditions that the maximum age limit in no case exceed 50 (fifty)years (including all concessions) please see para (2) of the General Conditions under part II of this Notification.

7. Qualification:

Working Knowledge of both Tamil and Malayalam languages.

Note: (1) In the case of Candidates advised for the post in the Registration Department, they should also pass 'handwriting test' in Tamil as per GO(Ms) 357/77/GAD dtd 04.10.1977

(2) Rule 10(a) (ii) of KS&SSR Part II is applicable.

Note: In addition to this qualification prescribed in the notification, the qualification recognized by executive orders or standing orders of Government as equivalent to a qualification specified for this post in the special rules or found acceptable by the Commission in cases where acceptance of equivalent qualifications is provided for in the rules and such of those qualification which presuppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the Government orders declaring equivalent/Higher qualification shall be produced as and when required by the commission.

8. Mode of Submitting Application:-

Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2012. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of taking of photograph. Candidates who are creating their profile newly from 1.1.2022, should upload the photograph taken within 6 months. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR card as ID. Proof in their profile.

12. Special Instructions to Candidates
