# NCA RECRUITMENT – STATEWIDE CATEGORY NO: 045/2023 THIRD NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited online only by "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" from qualified candidates belonging to the reservation group of Scheduled Tribe community of Kerala State for appointment in the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Before applying for the post, candidates shall register as per One Time Registration Scheme through the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1 Department : Kerala Higher Secondary Education

2 Name of Post : Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) Arabic

Explanation: Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) means Part-time post of Higher Secondary School

Teacher.

3 Scale of pay : ₹45,600 - 95,600/-

4 Number of vacancies : Scheduled Tribe - 02 (Two)

The above vacancies are now in existence. The NCA Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above mentioned community, but remained unfilled due to the paucity of candidates in the Ranked list published on 27.08.2019 for the post (category No.330/2017 Gazette dated 30.08.2017). This is the third NCA notification issued since qualified candidates belonging to the above mentioned community was not available in response to the First NCA notification dated 30.10.2020 ( Cat No-169/20 and Second NCA gazette notification dated 30.12.2021 ( Cat No-674/21) respectively.

5 Method of appointment - Direct Recruitment from among Scheduled Tribe community only.

Note:- Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than that mentioned above will be summarily rejected. Individual communication regarding the rejection of their application will not be issued.

6 Age limit - 20-45. [Only candidates born between 02.01.1978 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (including age relaxation in para 2 (i) of the General Conditions.)

Note: For other conditions regarding age relaxation, please see para 2 except para 2(i) of the General Conditions.

#### 7. **Qualifications:**-

- (1) Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 45% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by a University in Kerala.
- (2) (i) B.Ed in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by a University in Kerala.
  - (ii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed Degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.
  - (iii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree as specified in items (i) and (ii) above, persons with B.Ed. Degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
- (3) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test (SET) for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the

Note:-

- 1. Rule 10 a (ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.
- 2. In addition to the qualifications prescribed in the notification, the qualifications recognized by executive orders, or standing orders of Government as equivalent to a qualification specified for the post, in the Special Rules or qualifications found acceptable by the Commission since acceptance of equivalent qualifications is provided for in the Rules and such of those qualifications which pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the Government orders declaring equivalent/higher qualifications shall be produced as and when required by the Commission.
- The Degrees / Diplomas awarded by UGC approved universities or Institutions established through an act passed by Parliament / State Legislative assembly in accordance with the conditions laid down in G.O(M.S) No. 526/PD dated 17.07.1965 are acceptable for appointment in Government Services
- 4. In the absence of B.Ed Degree holders, candidates having Master's Degree with not less than 45% marks and who have passed the State Eligibility Test (SET) will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired Ph.D / M.Phil degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship / National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed Degree at their own expense within five years from the date of entry in service.
- Those who have passed Language Teachers Training Course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed. Qualification.
- 6. Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the concerned subject recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.
- 7. In the case of difference in Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.
- 8. Candidates who have acquired Non-qualifying Degrees viz. Ph.D/M.Phil/Post Doctoral Fellowship will be awarded weightage marks provided that such Non-Qualifying Degrees shall be in the subjects pertaining to the basic qualification stipulated for the post. Weightage marks for Non-qualifying Degrees for ranking will be awarded as detailed below.

Non-Qualifying M.Phil- 2 marks Non-Qualifying Ph.D- 4 marks Both M.Phil and Ph.D (Non-Qualifying)- 5 marks Post Doctoral Fellowship- 2 marks

Non-qualifying degree means the additional qualifications which are earned apart from the qualifications insisted on as essential qualifications for the post. If Ph.D/M.Phil/Post Doctoral Fellowship is reckoned as necessary qualification for the post, weightage marks will not be awarded for it. Weightage marks will be awarded only to those non-qualifying degrees which are claimed in the application and which are acquired on or before the last date for receipt of applications.

## Exemptions

- 1. Those who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
- Those who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
- Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed. degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility
  Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the
  Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in
  Kerala.
- 4. Teachers who have completed 10 (ten) years of approved teaching service at the High School level in the General Education subordinate service shall be exempted from passing the State

### **8** Mode of submitting Application:-

- (a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2013. Those candidates who create new profile 01.01.2022 onwards should upload their photograph taken within six months. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the print out of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondence with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original Documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
- (b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.
- (c) Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rule 22 of the Kerala Public Service Commission Rules of procedure shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualifications regarding education ,experience etc and are liable to be disqualified for being considered for a particular post or debarment from applying to the Commission either permanently or for any period or the invalidation of their answer scripts or products in a written/practical test or the initiation of criminal or other proceedings against them or their removal or dismissal from office or the ordering of any other disciplinary action against them if they have already been appointed or any one or more of the above
- (d) Candidates are required to acquaint themselves with the instructions given in the notification as Part II, General Conditions before submitting application for the post. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the General Conditions are liable to be rejected.
