- **5. Probation :** As per Rule 184 of KCS every person appointed to this post shall from the date on which he/she joins duty be on probation for a period of One year on duty within a continuous period of two years.
- **6. Method of appointment :** Direct Recruitment (Only from the eligible employees belonging to OBC Category)
- **7. Age Limit :** 18-43. Only candidates born between 02/01/1980 and 01/01/2005 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.
