Applications are invited online only by "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" from qualified candidates belonging to the reservation group of Scheduled Caste Converted to Christianity (SCCC) community of Kerala State for appointment in the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Before applying for the post, candidates shall register as per One Time Registration Scheme through the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1 Department : Kerala Higher Secondary Education

2 Name of Post : Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) Arabic

Explanation: Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) means Part-time post of Higher Secondary

School Teacher.

3 Scale of pay : ₹45,600-95,600/-

4 Number of vacancies : Scheduled Caste converted to Christianity (SCCC) – 2 (Two)

The above vacancies are now in existence. The NCA Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above mentioned community, but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates in the Ranked list published on 27.08.2019 for the post (category No.330/2017 Gazette dated 30.08.2017). This is the Second NCA notification due to the non availability of qualified candidates for the post as per the Ist NCA notification Cat No - 544/2022 Gazette dated 15.12.2022.

5 Method of appointment - Direct Recruitment from among Scheduled Caste Converted to Christianity (SCCC) community.

Note: Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than SCCC will be summarily rejected. Individual communication regarding the rejection of their application will not be issued.

Age limit

- 1. 20-43. [Only candidates born between 02.01.1980 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.] including age relaxation in para 2(i) of the General Conditions.

Note:- 1. In the case of adult members of Scheduled Caste Converted to Christian Religion and their children, the upper age limit shall be 45 years.

2. For other conditions regarding age relaxation, please see para 2 except para 2(i) of the General Conditions.

7. **Qualifications:**

- (1) Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by a University in Kerala.
- (2) (i) B.Ed in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by a University in Kerala.
 - (ii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed Degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.
 - (iii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree as specified in items (i) and (ii) above, persons with B.Ed. Degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.

(3) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test (SET) for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the agency authorized by the State Government. (GO(P)No.144/2001/Gl.Edn dated 16.04.2001).

Note:- 1. Rule 10 a (ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.

- 2. In the absence of B.Ed Degree holders, candidates having Master's Degree with not less than 50% marks and who have passed the State Eligibility Test (SET) will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired Ph.D/M.Phil degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed Degree at their own expense within five years from the date of entry in service.
- 3. Those who have passed Language Teachers Training Course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed. Qualification.
- **4.** Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the concerned subject recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.
- 5. In addition to the qualifications mentioned above, qualifications notified as equivalent to the prescribed qualification by way of executive orders or standing orders of the Government, as well as higher qualification which presuppose the basic qualifications prescribed for the post and the qualifications accepted by the Commission as equivalent to the qualifications specified in the Special Rules shall be acceptable. Government Orders regarding equivalent qualifications / higher qualifications shall be produced by the candidate as and when called for by the Commission.
- 6. In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate at the time of certificate verification.
- 7. Candidates who have acquired Non-qualifying Degrees viz. Ph.D/M.Phil/Post Doctoral Fellowship will be awarded weightage marks provided that such Non-Qualifying Degrees shall be in the subjects pertaining to the basic qualification stipulated for the post. Weightage marks for Non-qualifying Degrees for ranking will be awarded as detailed below.

Non-Qualifying M.Phil- 2 marks

Non-Qualifying Ph.D- 4 marks

Both M.Phil and Ph.D (Non-Qualifying)- 5 marks

Post Doctoral Fellowship- 2 marks

Non-qualifying degree means the additional qualifications which are earned apart from the qualifications insisted on as essential qualifications for the post. If Ph.D/M.Phil/Post Doctoral Fellowship is reckoned as necessary qualification for the post, weightage marks will not be awarded for it. Weightage marks will be awarded only to those non-qualifying degrees which are claimed in the application and which are acquired on or before the last date for receipt of applications.

Exemptions

- Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
- 2. Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
- 3. Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed. degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
- 4. The teachers who have completed 10 (ten) years of approved teaching service at the High School level in the General Education subordinate service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test. (GO(P)No.36/2005/Gl.Edn dated 04.02.2005)

8 Mode of submitting Application:

- Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2012. Those candidates who create new profile 01.01.2022 onwards should upload their photograph taken within six months. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the print out of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondence with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original Documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
- (b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.
- (c) Candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualifications regarding education, experience etc shall, as per Rule 22 of the KPSC Rules of Procedure, be liable to be disqualified from being considered for selection to any post to which they apply; or be prohibited from sending applications to the Kerala Public Service Commission permanently or for a specific period; or their answer scripts or products in the examination / practical test be invalidated; or legal proceedings initiated against; or be removed or dismissed from office, or any other disciplinary action initiated against them if they have already been appointed; or any one of the above actions or more of them initiated against such candidates.
- (d) Candidates are required to acquaint themselves with the instructions given in the notification as Part II, General Conditions before submitting application for the post. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the General Conditions are liable to be rejected.
