IV NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited through One Time Registration Scheme from qualified candidates belonging to reservation groups of under mentioned communities only in Kerala State for appointment in the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Name of the candidates and date of taking the photo should be printed on the photograph. This is the Fourth NCA notification for the post due to the non-availability of qualified candidates notified in the Gazette dated 30.11.2009, 16.04.2011, and 15.12.2012 as per Category Nos. 425/2009, 53/2011 and 633/2012 & 634/2012 respectively)

1. **Department** : **Higher Secondary Education Department**
2. **Name of Post** : **Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) - Mathematics**
3. **Scale of pay** : **₹ 16,180 – 29,180/-**
4. **Number of vacancies** : **Scheduled Caste –6 (Six) Category No.315/2015**
Scheduled Tribe –4 (Four)Category No.316/2015

The above vacancies are now in existence. The ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked to the above communities but remains unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked list published for the post with effect from 07.07.2008.

5. **Method of appointment** : **Direct Recruitment** (from candidates belonging Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes only.) In the absence of candidates in Scheduled Castes Scheduled Tribes will be considered and vice versa.

Note: The applications of candidates belonging to other than the communities mentioned in this notification will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

6. **Age limit** : **20-45.** Only candidates born between 02.01.1970 and 01.01.1995 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post. (Including relaxations in para 2(i) of the General Conditions). For other conditions regarding age relaxation please see para (2) of the General Conditions (except para 2(i)).

7. Qualifications:-

- (1) Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any of the Universities in Kerala.

- (2) (i) B.Ed Degree in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
- (ii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed Degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.
- (iii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree as specified in items (i) and (ii) above, persons with B.Ed. Degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.

OR

M.Sc. Ed in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any one of the Regional Institutes of Education sponsored by the National Council for Education Research and Training (NCERT).

- (3) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teachers conducted by Government of Kerala or by the agency authorized by the State Government.

Note : 1) Rule 10(a)ii of Part II KS &SSR is applicable.

- 2) Persons who have acquired M.Ed. in the subject concerned recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.

Exemptions

1. Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teacher.
2. Those persons who have passed National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
3. Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed. degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be the one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
4. The teachers who have completed 10(ten) years of approved teaching service at the High School level in the General Education subordinate service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:-

Before applying for the post, candidates should register as per “ONE TIME REGISTRATION” Scheme through the Official website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in. Those who have already registered can apply by logging in to their profile using his/her User-ID and Password. No application fee is required. Candidates can view, rectify defects and print the details in the registration card by clicking the link **Registration Card** after entering the home page. Candidates are responsible to ensure correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password and they shall keep in mind the user ID for further communication with the Commission.

Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove qualification, age, community etc have to be produced as and when called for.
