7. Qualifications:

- 1. Masters Degree in the concerned subject with atleast 55% marks or its equivalent and good academic record.
- 2. Must have passed a Comprehensive Test in the concerned subject specifically

conducted for the purpose by UGC or any agency duly constituted by the State Government in this behalf. When qualifications are equal preference shall be given to candidates who possess adequate knowledge in Malayalam.
