Note II :- Th**ose** who claim equivalent qualifications for the prescribed qualification should produce the relevant Government order to prove the equivalency of the qualification at the time of verification only be considered.

Note III :- In the case of difference in original caste/community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non creamy layer Certificate/ community certificate at the time of certificate verification.

The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, age, community, etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

b. If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a conformation on writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile . Such candidates alone can generate and download the
