Applications are invited online only as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" from qualified candidates of Latin Catholic/Anglo Indian Community of Kerala State for appointment in the undermentioned post in Kerala Government Service. No.503/2017).

The above vacancies is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid till candidates are advised and appointed against the above vacancy earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of Ranked list published on 28.09.2011(Cat. No.297/08) for the post.

- 5 Method of appointment** Direct Recruitment.(From candidates belonging to LC/AI community only)

Note:- 1. applications submitted by candidates belonging to communities other than the above mentioned community will be summarily rejected. Individual Communications regarding the rejection of their applications will not be issued.

2. In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a gazette notification in this regard, along with Non-Creamy layer certificate/Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.

- 6 Age limit** : **30-49;** [Only candidates born between **02.01.1970** and **01.01.1989** (both dates are included) are eligible to apply for the post.[including relaxation in para2(i) of the General Conditions.]

7. Qualifications

1. A Foreign Going Master’s Certificate granted by the Government of India or its equivalent with command experience for one year.

OR

Must have served as Officer not below the rank of Lieutenant Commander in the Indian Navy in the Executive Branch and must possess the certificate of Services as Master(Foreign Going) and not being in the active list there of.

Preferential:-Experience in piloting and/or dredging operation for one year or more.

2. Must be certified to possess the Visual Standard Specified below:

(iii) Each eye must have a full field of vision.

(iv) Squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or of the lids (Trachoma like) of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification but not colour blindness.

(ii) Applications of candidates who have claimed qualifications equivalent to those prescribed in the Gazette Notification for the post will be considered equivalent only if they produce Government order to prove equivalency at the time of verification.

Note:- Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the certificate as given above and vague statements such as Vision",Normal", "Good" ,"Average". etc will not be accepted . Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specifications are not as indicated above, the Officer issuing the certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of Vision or worse standards of Vision as the case may be. Otherwise the Certificate will not be accepted.

Candidates who claim experience should obtain a experience Certificate in the following format and should enter details in their profile regarding experience(Certificate number, date , name of post, period, issuing authority, name of institutions etc.) and upload scanned image of the same before submitting application. Candidates should produce the Certificate before the Commission as and when asked for the same.

- (1) Please specify the post held or nature of assignment, casual labourer, paid/unpaid, apprentice/regular worker or temporary worker.
- (2) All Experience Certificate shall be duly certified by the concerned Controlling Officer / Head of Office of the Government. The genuineness of the certificate shall be subjected to verification and legal action will be taken against those who issue and produce bogus certificate.
- (3) The experience qualification prescribed for appointment shall be acquired after obtaining the basic essential qualification.

Probation:- Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

Test:- Every person appointed to the post shall pass the following tests within the period of probation.

- (i) Account Test for executive officers of the Kerala State and
- (ii) Kerala Port Department Test(Higher Grade).

8. Mode of submitting Application:-

- (a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates shall click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom

portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link **Registration Card** in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

(b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected summarily. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.

(c) Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR Card as I.D Proof in their profile.
