FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited through 'One Time Registration' facility exclusively from qualified candidates belonging to reservation group of Dheevera community in the State of Kerala for appointment in the under mentioned post. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. **Department** : **Animal Husbandry**
2. **Name of post** : **Livestock Inspector Gr. II / Poultry Assistant/ Milk Recorder / Store Keeper / Enumerator**
3. **Scale of pay** : **Rs. 20000-45800/-**
4. **Number of vacancies** : **District wise**
: Dheevera - Pathanamthitta-01(One)

- Note** (i) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the community other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.
- (ii) A Ranked List will be prepared for Pathanamthitta District for the above mentioned community in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force for three years or until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List, whichever is earlier.

- (iii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O (MS) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district within a period of five years from the date of commencement of continuous service. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G O (P) No. 36/91/P&ARD, dated 2.12.1991. But as per G.O (P) No. 12/96/P&ARD dated 16.03.1996, the condition of 5 years service is not applicable for the transfer to the Districts of Idukki, Wayanad and Kasaragod. This concession will be available only for getting transfer into these districts, but not for getting transfer out of these districts and this concession will be granted only once in the career of Government Servant. Candidates already in Government Service holding the same post in the same department in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

- (iv) Candidates recruited by the Commission shall be appointed to the service provisionally and they shall undergo the Stockman training course / Livestock Inspector training course. After the successful completion of training, their provisional appointment will be regularized from the date of first appointment treating their training period as regular service. Those who do not complete the course successfully in the first attempt shall be allowed 3 (Three) more chances to complete the course successfully. In the case of candidates who fail to complete the course successfully even in the fourth attempt, their provisional appointment shall be terminated and they shall be discharged from service. There shall be no re-ranking of candidates based on the marks secured by them during the training.
- (v) Candidate selected will have to execute a bond in the prescribed form to serve the Government of Kerala for a minimum period of 5 years after the regular appointment. Those who leave the service in between or during training are liable to pay for the damage if any fixed by the Government.
- (vi) Each trainee will have to produce a certificate (in original) of physical fitness from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon. This certificate need be produced as and when called for by the Commission.
- (vii) If the community claim in the application differs from the community noted in SSLC, then such changes are to be published in the gazette on or before the date of verification of original documents and the same should be produced along with the Non creamy layer certificate issued by the Revenue authorities at the time of One Time Verification or as and when required by the commission.

- 5. **Method of appointment** :- Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to Dheevara, community)
- 6. **Age Limit** :- 18-39 (Candidates born between 02.01.1980 and 01.01.2001 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (Including the relaxation as per Para 2(i) of the General Condition).

Note:- [For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (fifty) years (including all concessions), please see Para 2 of the General Conditions of Gazette Notification except Para 2(i)].

7 **Qualifications:-**
A pass in VHSE with Livestock Management as main Subject.

- Note:-1) Differently Abled persons are not eligible for appointment to the post.
- 2) KS&SSR Part II Rule 10(a) (ii) is applicable for selection to the post.
 - 3) Those who claim equivalent qualification shall produce the respective Government Order to prove the claim at the time of One Time Verification or as required by the Commission.

8. **Mode of submitting Applications :-**

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' scheme through the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken on or after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, Experience, Community, Age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR card as I.D. Proof in their profile.

11. If Written Test/OMR/Online Examination is conducted as a part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their 'One Time Registration' profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calender itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobiles phones registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination.
