FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited exclusively from qualified candidates belonging to OBC/Scheduled Caste/ Ezhava/ Thiyya/ Billava reservation groups of Kerala State for selection to the following post. Applications shall be submitted online only through the official website of the Commission after ONE TIME REGISTRATION. Candidates who have registered can apply through their profile.

Note: 1) The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancy earmarked for above communities during the currency of the Ranked List published on 28/04/2020 (Category No. 438/2016) or three years from the date of Publication of this NCA ranked list whichever is earlier.

2) The Kerala Public Service Commission shall have the power to cancel the advice for appointment of any candidate to the above post, if it is subsequently found that such advice was made under some mistake. On such cancellation the appointing authority shall terminate the service of the candidates, provided that the cancellation of advice for appointment by the Commission and subsequent termination of service of the candidate by the appointing authority shall be made within the period of probation or 240 days from the date of joining duty whichever is earlier.

- 5 Method of appointment : **Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to OBC, Scheduled Caste, Ezhava/Thiyya/ Billava).**

Note : Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than the above mentioned communities will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.

6 Age : Scheduled Caste :18-41,Only candidates born between 02.01.1980 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (Including age relaxation to the community mentioned above).

OBC,Ezhava/Thiyya/Billava:18-39, Only candidates born between 02.01.1982 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (Including age relaxation to the community mentioned above).

Note:The provisional hands working in the above concern will be given age relaxation to the extent of their provisional service put in subject to a maximum of five years from the upper age limit provided they are within the prescribed age limit on the date of their first appointment in the above concern. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional hands should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and shall produce the same as and when required by the Commission. It would also be clearly specified in the Certificate that they were not working in the regular service of the concern.

Qualifications: (1) B.Sc (Forestry) Or B.Tech Forestry from a recognized University

(2) Physical Qualifications

(a) Height – 167 cms

(b) Chest – 81 cms with a minimum expansion of 5 cms.

Note:- Minimum Height and Chest measurements shall be 160 cms and 76 cms respectively for Scheduled Caste candidates. The minimum Chest expansion of 5 cm shall however be applicable to them also.

(c) Eye sight :- Must be certified to possess the visual standard specified below without glasses.

Note:- Each Eye must have a full field of Vision. Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye

will be deemed to be a disqualification.

- (3) Candidates should have good physique. They must be free from apparent physical defects like knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins, bow legs, deformed limbs, irregular and protruding teeth, defective speech and hearing.
- (4) Physical Efficiency Test.

Must qualify in any 5 events out of the 8 items specified below of the National Physical efficiency One Star Standard test.

Note: Candidates should produce at the time of Physical Efficiency Test a Medical Certificate in original in the form prescribed here under, Certifying to their physical fitness and eyesight without glasses. The Medical Certificate should be one obtained from a Medical Officer under the Government not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon.

The Physical measurements of the candidates will be taken at the time of Physical Efficiency Test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurements will not be admitted for the Physical Efficiency Test.

Note:-(1) Details regarding standards of Vision should be clearly stated in the Certificate as given above and Vague statements such as vision “Normal” “average” etc will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately against each item. If the Specifications are not as indicated above, the officer issuing the certificate should notify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision, as the case may be otherwise the certificate will not be accepted.

(2) Selected Candidates should undergo physical training and training in Forestry for which they will be sent after selection.

Note:-

1. Rule 10 a (ii) of Part II KS & SSR is applicable.
2. Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.
3. If the caste of a candidate is wrongly mentioned in the SSLC book, the

candidate should claim their original caste in the application and should produce the community certificate /Non -Creamy layer certificate issued from the revenue authority concerned along with the Gazette Notification of the same at the time of certificate verification.

4. Appropriate disciplinary action, based on KPSC Rules of Procedure (1976) Rule 22, will be pursued against those candidates who give confirmation for writing examination by making false claims about qualification such as education, experience etc regardless of whether they attend the examination or not.

8 **Mode of submitting applications**

(a) Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission **www.keralapsc.gov.in** before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2011. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. **Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application.** The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

(b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the

Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination.
