7. Qualifications:

- 1. MD in (Ayurveda) Panchakarma awarded by a recognised university
- 2. 'A' Class registration in the Travancore Cochin Medical Council

9. Mode of Submitting applications:

- a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission <u>www.keralapsc.gov.in</u> before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password by clicking on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link. The photograph uploaded in the profile should be one taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion in white background. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission.
