Applications are invited from qualified candidates for appointment in the undermentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Before applying for the post candidates should register as per One Time Registration through the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their Profile.

1. Department : Port Department

2. Name of Post : Naval Architect

3. Scale of pay : Rs.36140 – 49740

4. Number of vacancies : 1 (One)

The above vacancy is now existence. The Ranked list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancy noted above and that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of the currency of the list.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment

6. Age limit : 25 – 46. Only candidates born between 02.01.1970 and 01.01.1991 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities (For other conditions regarding the age relaxation please see part 2 of the General Conditions)

7. Qualifications:

**1. A Degree in Naval Architecture from a recognised university
And**

Experience for not less than three years in the basic design, construction and maintenance of floating crafts in shipyards recognised by the Mercantile Marine Department.

**2. In the absence of candidates with the above qualification, Higher National certificate in Naval Architecture.
And**

Experience for not less than seven years in the basic design, construction and maintenance of floating crafts in shipyards recognised by the Mercantile Marine Department.

**3. In the absence of candidates with the above qualification a degree in mechanical Engineering of a recognised University.
And**

Five years experience in basic design, construction and maintenance

of floating crafts in shipyards recognised by the Mercantile Marine Department. Candidates with experience in ship repairing will be preferred.

Note:-1.Rule 10(a)(ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.

2. The experience should be one acquired after the acquisition of the basic academic qualifications for the post.
3. Qualification of experience prescribed shall not apply in the case of SC/ST candidates for direct recruitment. The candidate so recruited shall acquire the experience qualification after recruitment.

All Experience Certificate shall be duly certified by the concerned Controlling Officer/ Head of Office of the Government. The genuineness of the certificate shall be subjected to verification and legal action will be taken against those who issue and produce bogus certificate.

8. Probation:- The persons appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

9. Test:- 1. Every person appointed to the post shall within the period of Probation pass the Account test for Executive Officers of the Kerala State and the Kerala PWD test unless he has previously passed the two tests.

10. Mode of submitting applications:

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password by clicking on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link . The photograph uploaded in the profile should be one taken on or after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion in white background. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the

personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is received as provisional and the details cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application submitted not in accordance with the conditions stipulated in the notification will be summarily rejected in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. The profile correction made by candidate or in the office of KPSC on request after the last date fixed for the receipt of application will not reflect in the application. Such corrections will be in effect on the date on which correction have made.
