7. Qualifications

1. <u>Educational Qualifications:</u>

(i). A Degree or Diploma in Automobile or Mechanical Engineering from any university established by statute or any Degree or Diploma declared equivalent thereto.
(Rule 10(a)(ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable)

(ii). Two years experience in a Government approved Automobile workshop in the case of Diploma Holders and one- year experience in the case of Degree Holders after the acquisition of the qualification referred to (i) above.

- (iii). Must have valid Heavy Duty Driving Licence for Driving.
- Note: (a) Must possess a current Driving Licence throughout all the stages of selection process as on the last date of receipt of application, OMR Test, Verification, Measurement, Practical Test, Interview etc..
 - (b) Driving Licence issued after 16.01.1979 should have separate endorsement of heavy-duty goods vehicles and heavy- duty passenger vehicles. Applications with only one endorsement will be summarily rejected.
 - (c) Differently abled persons are not eligible to apply in response to this notification

2. <u>Physical Qualifications:</u>

Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the above category shall undergo basic training for a period of six months in the Kerala Police Academy or Police Training College or in any other institution as may be prescribed by the Director General of Police. During the period of training the trainee shall be paid the minimum of the basic pay of the post as stipend. The period they undergone training will not count for the purpose of Probation, Increment, Promotion or Higher Grade and will not have any right or claim for payment of salary in the prescribed scale of pay which will be entitled to them only after passing the test conducted at the end of the training.

9. Mode of submitting Applications.
