Applications are invited from qualified Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates of Kerala State for selection to the following post. Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after ONE TIME REGISTRATION. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. The photo uploaded through One Time Registration should be the one taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of the photograph taken should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of photograph taken.

- Note:(i) The above Vacancies are now in existence. Separate Ranked List will be prepared for each district in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes during the currency of the list. Candidates against vacancies reported exclusively for Scheduled Tribes will also be advised from this list and only in the absence of Scheduled Tribe candidates in this list fresh notification for vacancies reserved exclusively for scheduled Tribes will be issued.
  - (ii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis subject to the Special conditions laid down in G.O (MS)No.154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List so prepared is not eligible for transfer to another District unless he/she complete five (5) years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former District. Even if, transfer is allowed after five (5) years, it will be subject to the orders contained in G.O(Ms)No.4/61/PD dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service, holding the post in any one District are restricted from applying for the same post in another District. But they can apply for higher posts when notified.
  - (iii) Candidates are not eligible to apply for the same post in more than one District. If a candidate applies to more than one District and gets selected, his/her selection will be cancelled and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her. Candidates should submit the application for the post to the concerned District Office and should not the name of the district against the relevant column of the online application.
  - (iv) Candidates from the Ranked List for districtwise selection will be advised for appointment against the Head quarters vacancies also. Appointment against the Headquarters vacancies

will be started from Thiruvananthapuram District. Separate option need not be given for this. The conditions laid down in G.O(P)No.27/13/PD dated 28.09.2013 shall be applicable to the candidates thus appointed.

5 Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment

(Special Recruitment from among Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes only).

Note:- Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6 Age : 18 – 41

Only Candidates born between 02.01.1974 and 01.01.1997 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

**Note:** In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit upper age limit shall be relaxed upto 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

## 7 Qualifications:

Must be able to read and write Malayalam or Tamil or Kannada.

- **Note:** 1 Rule 10 a (ii) of part II of KS&SSR is applicable.
  - 2) Physically Handicapped persons are not eligible for appointment to the post of Watcher, Watchman, Night Watcher, Marker (Medical College, Collegiate Education and Technical Education Department), Regular Marker (Animal Husbandry Department), Chainman (Land Revenue and Town Planning Department) and Lascar Gr II/Gate Keeper Gr II in Printing Department included in the Kerala Last Grade Service.
  - 3) Women candidates are not eligible for appointment to the following posts.
    - (a) Watchman of all categories, Watcher and Chowkidar.
    - (b) Cleaner-cum-Conductor
    - (c) Cleaner (Boat Cleaner, Tractor Cleaner, Van Cleaner, Ambulance Cleaner, Lorry Cleaner.)
    - (d) Fisherman
    - (e) Fisherman-cum-Watchman
    - (f) Boatman
    - (g) Lascar
    - (h) Bull Attendant
    - (i) Bull Keeper
    - (j) Chainman
    - (k) Lascar Grade II / Gate Keeper Gr II (Printing Department)
  - 4) Only persons professing Hindu Religious faith alone will be appointed to the post in the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Department.
  - 5) Only one common Ranked List will be prepared for the various posts in the Last Grade Service.
  - 6) Only women candidates are eligible for the post of Watch Woman.

- 7) Vacancies for Last Grade Service in Kerala Municipal Common Service will also be filled up from the Ranked List prepared for each district in pursuance of this notification without obtaining willingness from the candidates.
- 8) Candidates who have passed Std.VII and are included in the Ranked List prepared as per this notification for the post of LGS (Except Women and PH) are hereby instructed to furnish their willingness for being considered for the post of Lascar Grade II/Gate Keeper Grade II in the Government press along with proper medical certificate.

## 8 Mode of Submitting application:

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission <a href="www.keralapsc.gov.in">www.keralapsc.gov.in</a> before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a printout of the details in the profile by clicking the link Registeration Card. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of each application, the candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is treated as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
